INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT
The Board of Directors of AKC Steel Industries Limited
Report on the audit of the Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying quarterly financial results of AKC Steel Industries Limited (the company) for the quarter ended March 31, 2021 and the year to date results for the period from April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021, attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us these financial results:

i) are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and

ii) give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information for the quarter ended March 31, 2021 as well as the year to date results for the period from April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act). other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.
